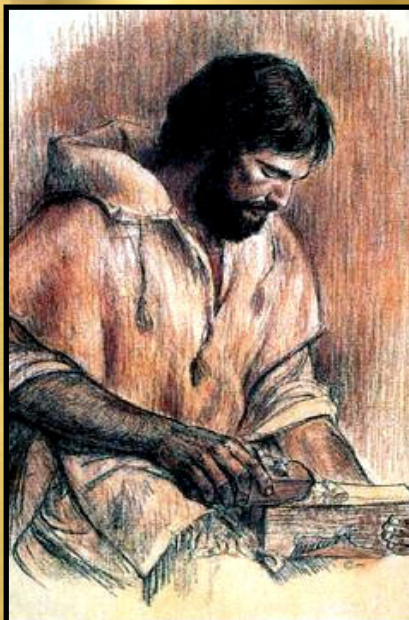

**Saint Joseph the Worker
Universal Feast day: May 1**

Jesus is identified in the Gospel of Matthew as the son of a τέκτων (*tekton*). *Tekton* has been traditionally translated into English as "carpenter", but is a rather general word (from the same root that gives us "technical" and "technology") that could cover makers of objects in various materials, even builders. But the specific association with woodworking is a constant in Early Christian tradition. In response to the "May Day" celebrations around the world that proclaim the greatness of



Communism and Socialism as political systems, Pope Pius XII instituted the feast of St. Joseph the Worker in 1955 and proclaimed St. Joseph as the patron saint against world Communism. But the relationship between Joseph and the cause of workers has a much longer history. In a constant effort to keep Jesus from being removed from ordinary human life, the Church has from the beginning proudly emphasized that Jesus was a carpenter, obviously trained by Joseph in both the satisfactions and the drudgery of that vocation. Humanity is like God not only in thinking and loving, but also in creating. Whether we make a table or a cathedral, we are called to bear fruit with our hands and mind, ultimately for the building up of the Body of Christ.

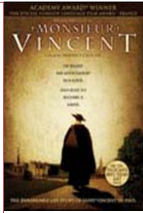
**CONFIRMATION AT OLMC
