## Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity June 11, 2017

On Trinity Sunday we remember and honor the belief of an eternal God, consisting of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Pope Gregory IX instituted Trinity Sunday in 828 AD. This day is notable for being the only major Christian festival that celebrates a doctrine of the church rather than an event in its sacred history. It falls on the Sunday following Pentecost each year. Christians are baptized in the name of the 'Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit:' not in their names, for there is only one God, the almighty Father, his only Son, and the Holy Spirit: the Most Holy Trinity. The faith of all Christians rests on

the Trinity. The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths of faith." The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin." The Trinity is a mystery of faith in the strict sense, one of the "mysteries that are hidden in God, which can never be known unless they are revealed by God."

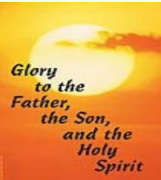

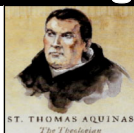
As disciples of Jesus Christ, we are called to put our gifts at the service of our Lord. Our gifts to the PSA make a difference to our diocese and our parish.

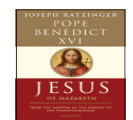

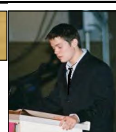

**THIS SUMMER...WHEN YOU COME TO MASS...ARE YOU DRESSED TO GO TO THE BEACH OR TO CHURCH?**

A primary goal when we participate in Liturgical Celebrations is to **bring glory to God**. If we dress in such a manner that someone is focusing on us instead of Christ, we have not met this goal. Participating at Mass is not a time of *self-expression*, but rather a time for our deepest **expression of devotion and reverence to our God** and the absence of self. As a rule of thumb, think to yourself: "If my *Grandmother* saw me going to Mass wearing what I have on, what would she say?" That may sound a bit silly but it captures the essence.
