**Saint Anthony of Padua
Feast Day: June 13
Patron Saint of Lost Articles**

St. Anthony was born in Lisbon in 1195. As a youth of fifteen, he joined the Clerks Regular of St. Augustine. Having been moved by the martyrdom of five Franciscans in Morocco, he was overcome with the desire to be a missionary in Africa and entered the order of Franciscans. Thereupon he received the name Anthony. He then went to Morocco but poor health forced him to return to Europe. The vessel taking him to Portugal was driven off course and eventually found safe harbor in Sicily.



Anthony disembarked and made his way to Assisi. Because of his special talent for preaching, he was assigned to preach against the heretics in northern Italy and southern France. He taught theology in several locations in Italy and was appointed superior over many communities. Despite his many duties and assignments he continued his preaching. So active was he that his health weakened and he died at the age of thirty-six near Padua on June 13, 1231. Less than a year later he was canonized by Pope Gregory IX. He was named a Doctor of the Church by Pope Pius XII in 1946. As a saint he is considered a helper in time of need—a reference to the popular custom of seeking his intercession whenever something is lost.

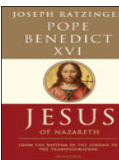
Completed *Enrollment Envelopes* may be returned in the Sunday collection or at anytime by placing them through the mail slot in the Rectory Door.

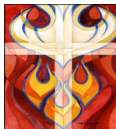
