Saint Kateri Tekakwitha
Feast day: July 14

Saint Kateri Tekakwitha is the first Native American to be recognized as a saint by the Catholic Church. She was born in 1656, in the Mohawk village of Ossernenon in the Mohawk Valley, now known as Auriesville, New York. Her mother was an Algonquin, who was captured by the Mohawks and who took a Mohawk chief for her husband. Kateri contracted smallpox as a four-year-old child which scarred her skin. The scars were a source of humiliation in her youth. Her entire family died during the outbreak. St. Kateri was



subsequently raised by her uncle, who was the chief of a Mohawk clan. At age 19, Kateri Tekakwitha converted to Catholicism and pledged her life to God, taking a vow of chastity and pledging to marry only Jesus Christ. Her decision was very unpopular with her adoptive parents and neighbors. To avoid persecution, she traveled to a Christian native community south of Montreal. Sadly, just five years after her conversion to Catholicism, she became ill and passed away at age 24. Her name, Kateri, is the Mohawk form of Catherine, which she took from St. Catherine of Siena. St. Kateri was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI on Oct. 21, 2012. She is the patroness of ecology and the environment, people in exile and Native Americans.

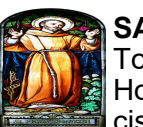


JOIN THE OLMC LECTOR MINISTRY
