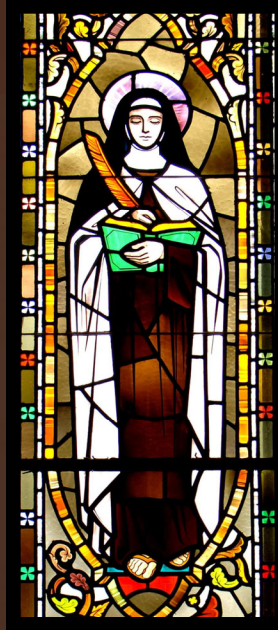

SAINT TERESA OF AVILA
Liturgical Feast day: October 15
Central figure in the rear left panel in our
OLMC stained-glass windows.

What do you know about this well-known saint? Saint Teresa of Ávila, also called Saint Teresa of Jesus, was a prominent Spanish mystic, saint, Carmelite nun, and author during the Counter Reformation, and theologian of contemplative life through mental prayer. She was a reformer of the Carmelite Order and is considered to be, along with Saint John of the Cross (in the central window panel on the opposite side of the church), a founder of the Discalced (shoeless) Carmelites. Saint Teresa is depicted



writing in a green and gold book, green is the color of life and gold is the color of purity. She wrote copious amounts of advice to the convents she founded, and wrote an explanation of her spirituality to the Spanish bishops. Her writings, along with the work of Saint John of the Cross, form the foundation of modern Christian mysticism. In 1622, forty years after her death, she was canonized by Pope Gregory XV, and in 1970 was named the first female Doctor of the Church by Pope Paul VI. Her books, which include her autobiography, *The Life of Teresa of Jesus*, and her seminal work, *The Interior Castle*, are an integral part of the Spanish Renaissance literature as well as Christian mysticism and Christian meditation practices as she entails in her other important work *The Way of Perfection*.

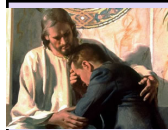

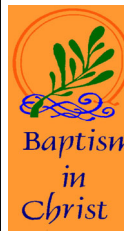


WORLD MISSION SUNDAY – OCT 21-22 ANNUAL COLLECTION

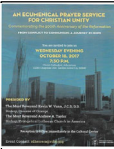

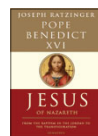
