**Sts. Simon and Jude, Apostles  
Feast Day: October 28**

In the listings of the Apostles found in the New Testament. St. Simon is called "the Zealot" and he is probably so identified as to distinguish him from Simon Peter. That he should be called the Zealot may be because he might have, at one time, belonged to the Jewish Zealot party. St. Jude is called "Judas, son of James" in Luke's Gospel, but is called Thaddaeus in Matthew's. He is sometimes identified as a relative of Jesus, but is clearly distinguished from Judas Iscariot. Judas Thaddaeus became known as Jude after early



translators of the New Testament from Greek into English sought to distinguish him from Judas Iscariot and subsequently abbreviated his forename. It is far from certain where either Simon or Jude preached after Pentecost: some sources claim that Simon preached in Persia (modern Iran) and Babylonia (now Iraq), while Jude preached in Palestine and the Near East. Both Simon and Jude were martyred in the first century, and both have been commemorated in Rome on the same day since the ninth century. St. Jude may also have been the author of one of the epistles in the New Testament. He is the patron of those in despair and of hopeless causes. A shrine dedicated to Saint Jude is found in the rear vestibule of our church.

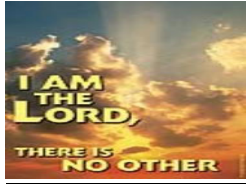

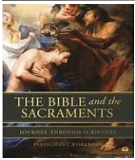
