Feast of the
Queenship of Mary
August 22

Pope Pius XII established the Feast of the Queenship of Mary in 1954. But Mary's Queenship has roots in Scripture. At the Annunciation, the Archangel Gabriel announced that Mary's Son would receive the throne of David and rule forever. At the Visitation, Elizabeth calls Mary "mother of my Lord." As in all the mysteries of Mary's life, Mary is closely associated with Jesus: Her queenship is a share in Jesus' kingship. We can also recall that in the Old Testament the mother of the king has great influence in court. The mother of the king



is always referred to as the Queen Mother. In the 4th century Saint Ephrem called Mary "Lady" and "Queen." Later Church fathers and doctors continued to use the title. Hymns of the 11th to 13th centuries address Mary with the title "Queen: e.g., "Hail, Holy Queen," "Hail, Queen of Heaven." The Dominican rosary and the Franciscan crown celebrate her queenship. This feast is a logical follow-up to the Assumption and is now celebrated on the octave day of that feast. In his 1954 encyclical *To the Queen of Heaven*, Pope Pius XII points out that Mary deserves the title because she is Mother of God and because she is closely associated as the New Eve with Jesus' redemptive work, and because of her intercessory power.

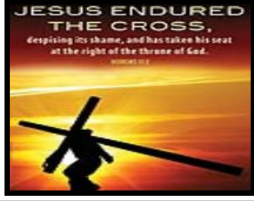
