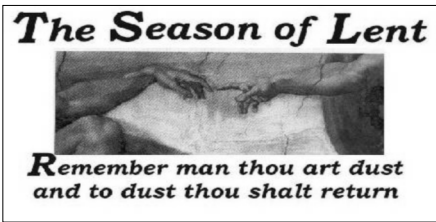
Psalm — In the sight of the angels I will sing your praises, Lord. (Psalm 138)

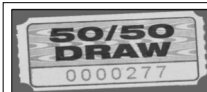

CHURCH GUIDELINES REGARDING
ABSTINENCE AND FASTING DURING LENT

Abstinence from meat is a penitential practice which consists of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. There is no upper age limit.

Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 years, inclusive. Fasting means that one full meal and two smaller meals may be taken which are sufficient to maintain strength according to one's needs but, together, do not equal another full meal. Fasting also means that eating between meals is not permitted. Drinking liquids between meals is acceptable.
