### Eucharistic Adoration

The fourth day of every month, except if the fourth day falls on Sunday or a national holiday.

### Sacrament of the Sick

In the event of a serious illness or a medical emergency, Monsignor Baird should be contacted immediately so that the Sacraments of the Church may be celebrated.

### Funerals

At the death of a loved one, please notify Monsignor Baird so that a date and time for the Funeral Liturgy may be arranged.

### Sacrament of Matrimony

Registration and preparation are required. Please contact the Chapel six months in advance of desired wedding date. At least one member of the engaged couple must be a practicing Catholic and a member of the Chapel at least one year prior to the wedding date.

### Baptisms

Baptisms are usually scheduled for the first Sunday of every month. Sacramental preparation is requested for parents and Godparents.

A Godparent must be a practicing and confirmed Catholic and, if married, married in the Church.

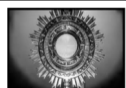

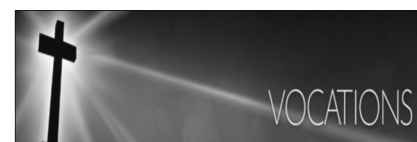
