**GOOD FRIDAY
IS A DAY OF ABSTINENCE AND FASTING**

***Abstinence** is a penitential practice which consists of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older.

***Fasting** means that one full meal is allowed; and two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together should not equal another full meal. Fasting also means that eating between meals is not permitted, although drinking of liquids is allowed. Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 years.

At the death of a loved one, please notify Monsignor Baird so that a date and time for the Funeral Liturgy may be arranged.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Registration and preparation are required. Please contact the Chapel six months in advance of desired wedding date. At least one member of the engaged couple must be a practicing Catholic and a member of the Chapel at least one year prior to the wedding date.

Baptisms

Baptisms are usually scheduled for the first Sunday of every month. Sacramental preparation is requested for parents and Godparents. A Godparent must be a practicing and confirmed Catholic and, if married, married in the Church.
