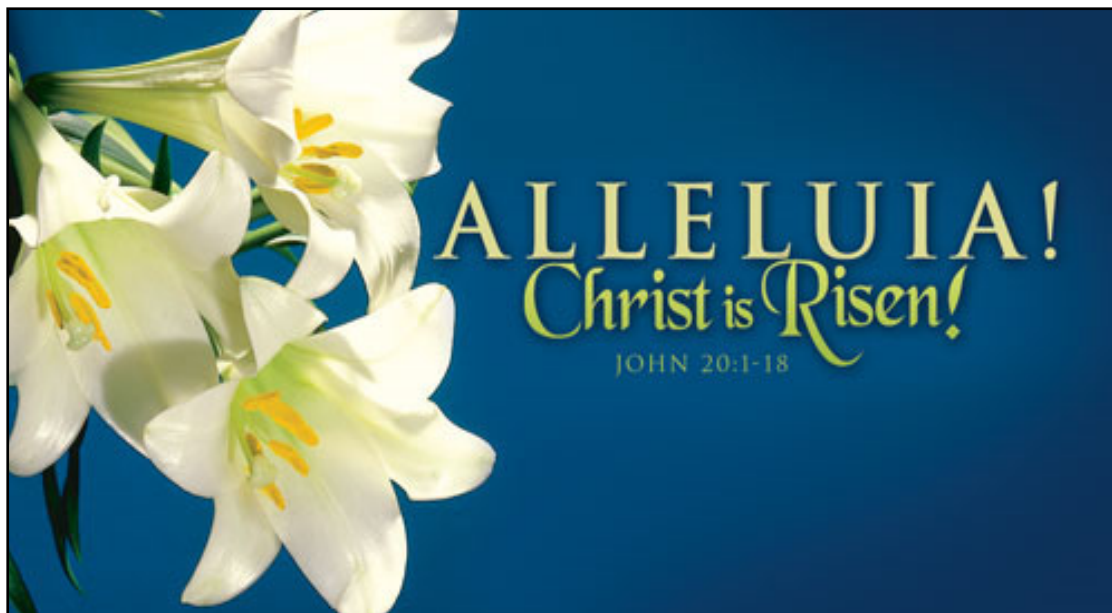

### **Weekday Eucharist**

Monday through Friday.....7:45 a.m.

### **Holy Day Eucharist**

Holy Day.....7:45 a.m.

### **Rosary**

Monday through Friday.....7:15 a.m.

### **Eucharistic Adoration**

The fourth day of every month, except if the fourth day falls on Sunday  
or a national holiday.

### **Sacrament of the Sick**

In the event of a serious illness or a medical emergency, Monsignor Baird  
should be contacted immediately so that the  
Sacraments of the Church may be celebrated.

### **Funerals**

At the death of a loved one, please notify Monsignor Baird so that  
a date and time for the Funeral Liturgy may be arranged.

### **Sacrament of Matrimony**

Registration and preparation are required. Please contact the Chapel  
six months in advance of desired wedding date. At least one member of the  
engaged couple must be a practicing Catholic and a member of the Chapel  
at least one year prior to the wedding date.

Sacramental preparation is requested for parents and Godparents.

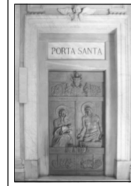
