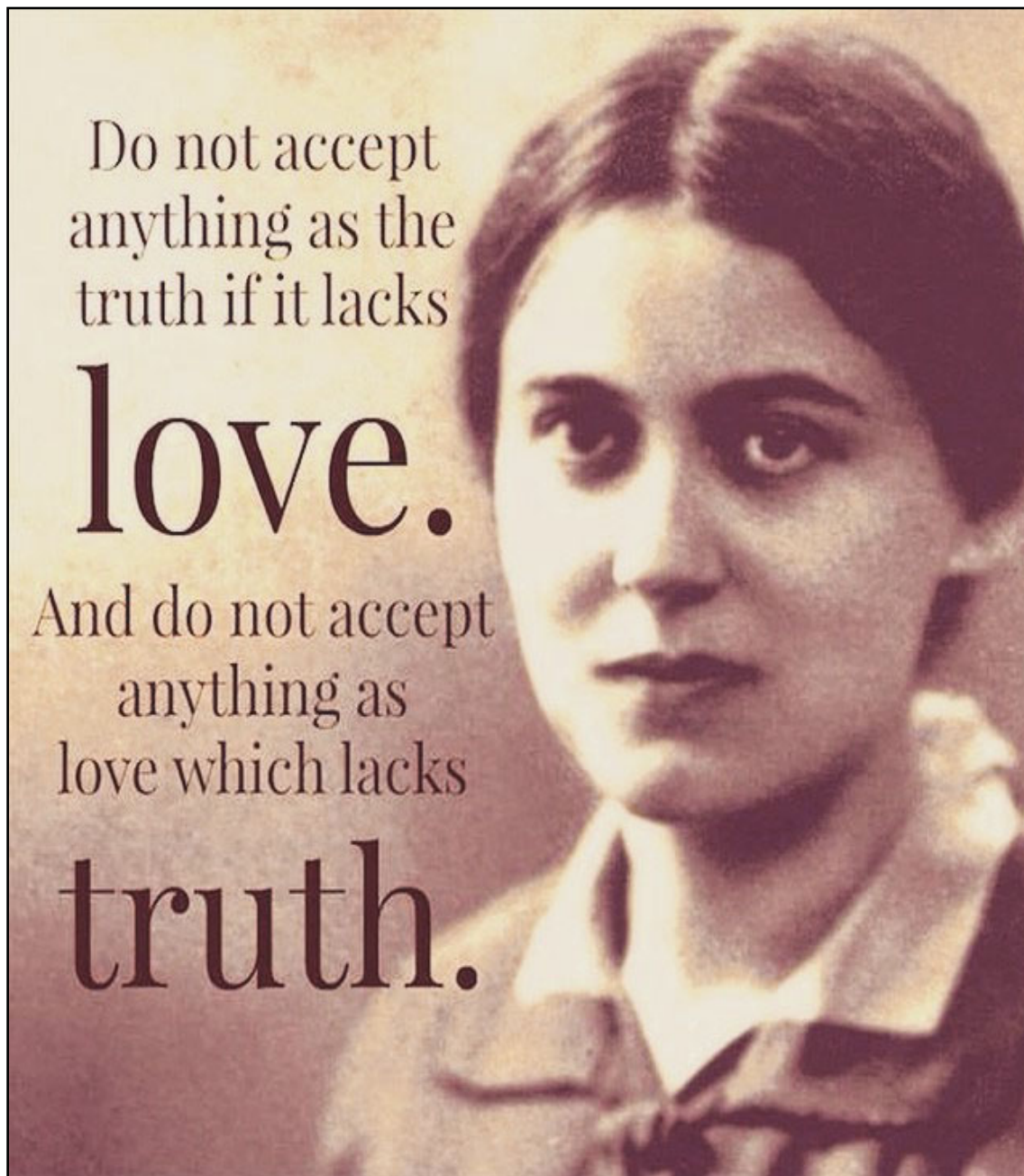

**WHAT IS RCIA AND WHO IS IT FOR?**

The **Rite of Christian initiation of Adults (RCIA)** is a process whereby new members join the Catholic Church and is designed specifically for adults who have never been baptized and who want to inquire about the Catholic faith, for adults who have been baptized into another Christian tradition who want to inquire about the Catholic faith, and for baptized Catholic adults who have not completed the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation and need more faith formation.

or a national holiday.

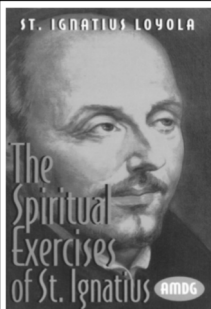
**Sacrament of the Sick**

**Funerals**  
At the death of a loved one, please  
notify Monsignor Baird so that  
a date and time for the Funeral Liturgy  
may be arranged.

**Sacrament of Matrimony**  
Registration and preparation are  
required. Please contact the parish  
office six months in advance of desired  
wedding date. At least one member of  
the engaged couple must be a  
practicing Catholic and a member of the  
Chapel at least one year prior  
to the wedding date.

**Baptisms**  
Baptisms are *usually* scheduled for  
the first Sunday of every month.  
Sacramental preparation is requested  
for parents and Godparents.  
A Godparent must be a practicing and  
confirmed Catholic and, if married,  
married in the Church.
