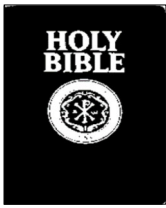
They will share how we can “become mercy” in our world.

This will be our Diocese’s **22nd Annual Pennies from Heaven Campaign.** Please consider

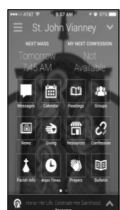
donating your coins and dollars to local Respect Life shelters, clinics, and centers that give immediate and long-term care for Orange County women, men, and families in crisis.
